An annual report is just one snapshot in the lifetime of any organization. A scenic viewpoint along the journey; an opportunity to look back and see how far we've traveled together and chart a course for the road ahead.

Thank you for making 2013 a successful year. We are honored to help you achieve your charitable goals and create your legacy. We are grateful for your confidence in our stewardship of community resources. In this annual report, we celebrate our role as your community foundation and highlight your successes as community leaders and philanthropists.

Through your incredible generosity, The Alaska Community Foundation corpus grew to over \$68 million held in 316 different charitable funds by the end of 2013. Our investment returns surpassed our internal benchmark and reached 15.21%. This enabled us to grant over \$3.5 million dollars to nonprofits and charitable causes across the state, from a student's vision of a vertical farm at Highland Tech Charter School to helping Elders access clean water in the village of Kalskag and the 45 different communities in between. We also grew our Affiliate community fund program, establishing four new Affiliates in Ketchikan, Sitka, Kodiak and Fairbanks.

But the numbers only tell a fraction of the story...

In 2013, you made an incredible impact. You supported dozens of Alaska's nonprofits in developing their strategic plans, strategizing for financial stability and restructuring operating models in an effort to improve their internal capacity. You supported Alaska Winter Olympians in their bids for gold at Sochi and made ACF the home for sustaining philanthropic activities of several private family foundations. Donors like you made a real difference from a \$1,000,000 donation to the Covenant House of Alaska to making college more affordable for students like UAF Music Education student Jared Caiazza.

You made a lasting impact in Alaska and we thank you for allowing us to be a part of your philanthropic legacy. We hope you enjoy the opportunity to reflect on 2013 and join us in celebrating why we are so proud to call Alaska home.

We at ACF are inspired by your generosity and commitment to improving the quality of life in Alaska. In 2013, donors like you established 22 funds supporting causes and organizations, meeting the ever-changing needs of our diverse and unique state.

Agency Funds

GRANTS & PROJECT HIGHLIGHTS

Through your generous donations and community support, The Alaska Community Foundation made 417 grant awards across the state of Alaska. Over \$3.5 million in grants and scholarships were awarded to the causes you care about.

Million to Covenant House

At The Alaska Community Foundation, we know that philanthropy is a deeply personal decision. While some donors are comfortable with public recognition, there are many who prefer that their philanthropy remains anonymous. The opportunity for anonymous giving is a key benefit and core component to ACF. Working through ACF in 2013, a fund advisor made a \$1,000,000 anonymous donation to Covenant House in support of their new building to house homeless youth and to set up an endowment fund to benefit homeless youth served by Covenant House.

Recover Alaska Project

Finding solutions for large, complex issues requires many partners. In 2013, ACF joined several funders behind Recover Alaska, a multi-sector collaborative project to reduce the negative impacts attributed to alcohol abuse in Alaska. As a fiscal sponsor, ACF is underwriting two Anchorage Daily News reporters examining the social costs of alcohol use and abuse.

Strengthening Organizations

From Kotzebue to Ketchikan to Nikiski—Alaska is home to a network of stellar nonprofit organizations providing vital community programs and services. Sometimes, an organization needs some extra support to rise to the next level. Whether it is funding for a strategic plan or to engage the services of a skilled facilitator, the

AFFILIATE HIGHLIGHTS



In 2008, with generous support from Rasmuson Foundation, ACF launched the Community Asset Building Initiative (CABI) to establish Affiliate community funds across the state. Helping Alaskans give where they live, CABI grows local philanthropy.

Chilkat Valley Community Foundation

- Project Highlights – The Chilkat Valley Community Foundation recommended \$10,500 in competitive grants to seven local community organizations, including the Southeast Alaska Independent Living Center to help provide greater support for local residents living with disabilities.

Jessica Stevens Community Foundation

- Project Highlights – The Jessica Stevens Community Foundation recommended over \$11,200 in competitive grants to seven local community organizations, including the Upper Susitna Seniors' Meals on Wheels program.

Kenai Peninsula Foundation

- Project Highlights – The Kenai Peninsula Foundation recommended \$5,800 in competitive grants to 14 local community organizations, including the Central Peninsula Birth Network for a "Rock & Roll" tent for nursing infants and their families.

Petersburg Community Foundation

- Project Highlights – The Petersburg Community Foundation recommended \$9,000 in competitive grants to six local community organizations, including the Petersburg Humane Association for the animal spay and neuter program.

Seward Community Foundation

- Project Highlights – The Seward Community Foundation recommended \$44,000 in competitive grants to 17 local community organizations, including the Independent Living Center to support outdoor activities for individuals with a disability.

Golden Heart Community Foundation (Fairbanks)

- Project Highlights – In their initial year, the Golden Heart Community Foundation received \$62,007 in local gifts to jumpstart their endowment.

Greater Sitka Legacy Fund

- Project Highlights – In their initial year, the Greater Sitka Legacy Fund

received \$27,470 in local gifts to jumpstart their endowment.

Ketchikan Community Foundation

- Project Highlights – In their initial year, the Ketchikan Community Foundation received \$35,520 in local gifts to jumpstart their endowment.

Kodiak Community Foundation

- Project Highlights – In their initial year, the Kodiak Community Foundation received \$45,450 in local gifts to jumpstart their endowment.

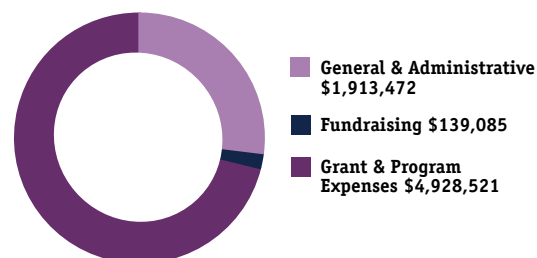

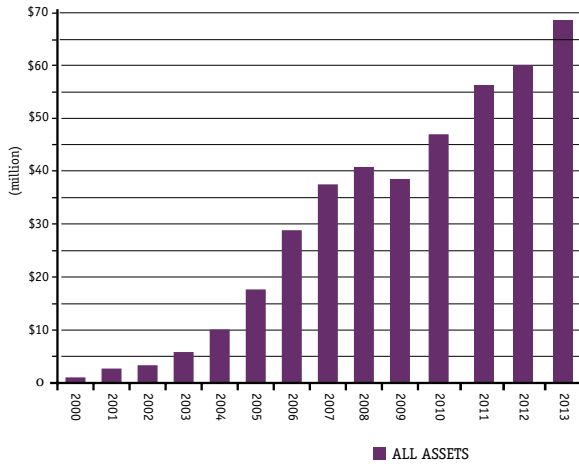

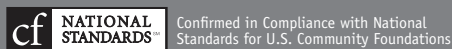
